- P.L. 108-83 provided \$442 million in fiscal year 2003 disaster relief. The President's request for these funds is shown within the totals for P.L. 108-69.
- The President requested these funds for fiscal year 2005; for comparison purposes, both of those amounts are shown in the request column for fiscal year 2004.
- The President requested \$10,276 million for fiscal year 2004 and \$1,579 million in fiscal year 2005; for comparison purposes, both of those amounts are shown in the request column for fiscal year 2005.
- P.L. 109-174 transferred \$712 million in budget authority that was originally provided in P.L.109-62 from the Federal Emergency Management Agency's Disaster Relief Fund to the Small Business Administration's disaster loan program. The President requested \$1,254 million in additional budget authority.
- P.L. 110-252 provided \$115,808 million in supplemental appropriations for fiscal year 2008 and \$85,155 million in supplemental appropriations for fiscal year 2009; each of those amounts is shown within each respective fiscal year in this table.
- This act expanded the scope of an existing appropriated entitlement (compensation for veterans affected by Agent Orange). The President requested, and the act provided, an additional \$13,377 billion in mandatory budget authority for this purpose.
- This act provided \$129 million in fiscal year 2010 for salaries and expenses of the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office. It also rescinded \$129 million from the fiscal year 2010 appropriation for Periodic Censuses and Programs. The President requested an additional \$139 million in budget authority for fiscal year 2010 and proposed rescissions of \$139 million.
- In this legislation, Congress did not consider \$5,360 million in budget authority requested by the President, including amounts for certain settlement payments, response to Gulf Coast oil spills, and border security.
- Division B of P.L. 114-223 (Zika Response and Preparedness Act, 2017) provided \$1,108 million in budget authority in fiscal year 2016; the President requested \$1,797 million. Division C (Continuing Appropriations Act, 2017) provided \$500 million in fiscal year 2016 for disaster relief and Division D (Rescissions of Funds) rescinded \$400 million in previously appropriated budget authority; the President did not request additional amounts for disaster relief or propose amounts for rescission.
- Division B of P.L. 114-254 (Security Assistance Appropriations Act, 2017) provided \$10,075 million in budget authority in fiscal year 2017 for overseas contingency operations.
